CONSOLIDATION *EX ANTE*

- Hierarchy in Brussels Ia
 - Common habitual residence
 - Last common habitual residence
 - Habitual residence of the defendant

 - National conflict rules or the habitual residence of the applicant

- Hierarchy + choice of court



CONSOLIDATION *EX ANTE*

- Maintenance Regulation
 - keeping *status quo*



CONSOLIDATION *EX POST*

- Transfer of jurisdiction
 - matrimonial matters
 - parental responsibility
 - maintenance



CONSOLIDATION *EX POST*

- Transfer of jurisdiction
 - at the request of one of the parties
 - assessment of the interests of justice
 - best interests of the child
 - good communication among judges
